**Joe Getzin**— Ole Miss— Head Volleyball Coach. Beginning in 1987 with Arizona, Joe has been one of the top recruiters at Arizona, Portland, South Carolina and since 2002 has led the Ole Miss Volleyball Team. Joe has led the team to two NCAA Tournament Spots and has been named SEC Coach of the Year Twice. Joe was a runner up for National Coach of the Year in 2006.



**Tonya Johnson** – Georgia Tech – Head Coach Prior to Georgia Tech Tonya was assistant head. Coach at UT, she was an assistant for 5 years at LSU and 3 years at the University of Kentucky. Was a four year letter winner at LSU as a player and helped her team to a final four appearance.



**Sally Polhamus** – Winthrop – Head Coach and recruiting coordinator. Prior assistant at Ga. Tech., 12 years of Division I coaching experience. Prior to Tech was an assistant coach at Indiana University and University of Dayton. Was an All A-10 player at Xavier and holds career kills at Xavier University.



**Sam Ojie** – Assistant Coach and recruiting coordinator for University of Oklahoma. Sam began his coaching career at Tulane, Central Florida and Georgia prior to becoming assistant at Oklahoma. Besides a stint as MVP on his college team, he played professionally in France and England.



**Kris Grunwald** - Assistant Coach Arkansas University. Since coming to Arkansas, Grunwald has focused his attention on recruiting and opponent breakdown in his first season at Arkansas. He helped coordinate Arkansas' top 45 recruiting class in 2009. Grunwald, a three time All American, was both an assistant and later the head coach at Auburn University, compliance officer at Michigan and assistant at Morehead State prior to Arkansas.



**Jill Kramer** – Assistant Coach – Univ. of Virginia 7 years Division I coaching experience. Prior to her arrival at Virginia she was an assistant at the University of Alabama, and UTSA. She has been working with the US A2 National Team and development program. As a player she was a team leader for the TCU Horned Frogs. Jill is recognized for her training and recruiting skills.



**Molly Alvey**—Head Coach—Univ. of Houston As only the 5th coach in Houston history, Molly brings talent and great recruiting ability to the Houston program. Previously Molly was the associate head coach at Ole Miss for 5 years helping the Rebels to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in program history followed by a second appearance in the NCAA's. Prior to Ole Miss she helped Temple to the sweet 16 in the NCAA Tournament.



**Genny Volpe**—Head Coach—Rice University 15 years college coaching experience. Helped lead Texas A&M three consecutive years to NCAA tournament. Prior to that she was an assistant for 5 years when SMU started their volleyball program. She was a 4 year letter winner at Texas A&M as a setter and outside hitter. She still holds Aggie records for most matches and games played.



**Reed Sunahara** - Head Coach-Cincinnati During Reed's 10 year tenure at Cincinnati, he has become the winningest coach in UC history amassing 207 victories, 3 conference championships, nine 20 win seasons, and 5 trips to the NCAA Tournament. A two-time all-American, Sunahara played with Olympians Karch Kiraly, Ricci Luyties, Doug Partie, and Dave Saunders during his career. In 1988, he went to Spain to play professionally for Cisneros Isla Verdes.



**Jill Lytle Wilson** – Assistant Coach – LSU Recruiting assistant in her 3rd year at LSU, Jill's collegiate coaching career began at Tennessee Martin, then to North Carolina where she helped the team to a 34-2 record. After one year at Wake Forest, she joined the LSU staff. During her collegiate career, Jill was a four year starter for LSU and one of the top servers in the SEC.
