TAV SUMMER CAMPS: Our camps are a great opportunity for players to improve and be seen by College and TAV Coaches. Our camps are designed to stretch your abilities and provide enough repetitions to help with memory retention of proper techniques. Our success is based upon these proven techniques and each of our coaches is an expert in instruction and drills using these techniques. Please take a moment to review our options and select the camps that are best suited to improve your game.

FEATURED CAMP INFORMATION

SETTER ACADEMY: Four-day (20 hours total) setting academy led by Ping Cao, designed to give setters over 2,000 touches on the ball. Techniques are broken down from footwork to release. A must do camp for setters. Training will be a 3 hour session each morning and a 2 hour session each afternoon. Training consists of Footwork training, hand development, decision making, ball placement, 1st, 2nd, & 3rd tempo sets, conditioning, and much more.

HITTER ACADEMY: Four-day(20 hours total) hitter academy designed to give attackers hundreds of ball control and attacking repetitions. All techniques will be analyzed and broken down; from starting posture, approach footwork, jump mechanics, arm drive, armswing, shot placement, and landing. Players will work on attacking 1st, 2nd, and 3rd tempo sets, along with pass transition, dig transition, and block transition. This camp is a must for all attackers!

COLLEGE COACHES ELITE CAMP: Three-day (15 hours total) college coach's camp has provided outstanding training for players getting ready for Nationals and for players aspiring to play in college. We have again assembled an outstanding group of college coaches. This year's camp will again feature college level drills and technical training with the opportunity to train alongside college coaches. Although we are providing a fun atmosphere to work in, we feel that the experience should be demanding enough that the players and parents feel their money is well spent. We look forward to seeing you at our camp. Parents are welcome to observe during all three day's sessions.

SERVING CLINIC: Single hour sessions devoted to all aspects of serving. Mindset, hand position, footwork, arm position and serve location will all be covered in this one hour session. Make your serve a game winner and be the most consistent server around.

BALL CONTROL: Two hour sessions designed to teach proper techniques in serve receive, digging and hand passing. Each session will be up tempo with extra focus on technique. Learn from the best while you improve your defensive game.

HITTER CLINIC: Two full hours of hitting instruction. Focus will be on arm swing mechanics, footwork transition, ball control and blocking. Instruction will include in and out of system hitting techniques as well as positional blocking.

SETTER CLINIC: Two hours of setter training with a focus on hand placement, footwork, set tempo, location and including additional training on defense and attacking.

HITTER/SETTER COMBO CLINIC: 10 hours of work with a combination of the Hitter and Setter Clinic with separate training as well as combined group training. Setters get your hitters to attend with you and hitters get your setters to come to get ready for the school season.

ELITE ALL SKILLS: 10 hours of intense training with a focus on all of the major volleyball skills, including passing, hitting, setting, serving, blocking, floor defense. High level and intense this camp will hone all of your volleyball skills.

JUNIOR HIGH ELITE AND BACK TO SCHOOL CAMPS: This 3-DAY/3-HOUR camp will touch on fundamental skills but will focus on the more advanced skills training and positional training. This camp is designed to give the experienced volleyball player an intense preparation for their upcoming middle school/junior high season. Campers are divided by age, skill level, and experience onto courts which provide the appropriate learning environment. To participate in the Elite camp you need to have played club volleyball or have played on 7th or 8th grade team. The Back to School emphasis will be on getting skills ready for Junior High tryouts. Included will be general skills training, with some positional specific training and wash play to get players ready for school ball.

NOTE: We will be splitting each camper by ability and then by age group.
