July 2009 Update!

WOW!! What a finish to the year. Nationals started with the 12's and 13's doing a great job, competing and setting the bar for the older teams. 16 Molten became the first 2nd team in TAV history to win matches in the open division and compete for the top three spots in their gold pool. 17 Molten wins their first 6 matches on the way to an excellent finish. 16 Asics and 17 Asics play some incredible matches and force their competitors to play their best matches to win!

AND THEN first up is the 15 Molten on center stage playing for only our 2nd National Championship in TAV history. After a great match we got our first medal, a silver to start the ball rolling. Battling all the way to the 3rd round in Gold, the 15 Advantage Team locks up the Bronze Division in a great finish. Next up was the steam rolling 15 Asics, peaking at just the right time and on that big stage, getting TAV our first ever Open National Championship Gold Medal winning over the AAU National Champion MAVS in 2. Only two Texas teams in history have won National Championships in the open division at Nationals and now 15 Asics makes it three.

18 Asics then made a run through the 18's open division to finish in a tie for first in the pool while knocking off the number 4 seed M1. Next up was an amazing match with Austin Juniors that Austin won in the 5th. 18 Asics then won out to win the Silver beating #2 Seed Moxie and local rival Skyline to finish in the top 10. Not to be outdone by the younger teams, 18 Molten got better and better, improving each match and reached medal round where they finally lost in a close match to AVA but won Bronze Medals for their efforts. 14 Molten, trying to copy the 15 Molten team won their first 6 matches and were barely beaten in the challenge round, knocking them out of the run to gold.

Last but not least, the 14 Asics watched their 15 Asics sisters win the gold and vowed to finish the same way. Each match they continued to improve with great attitude and incredible teamwork and in the semi finals beat an excellent OVA team that beat KIVA for the AAU National Championship. The finals against Invasion was a closely competitive match, but after two games 14 Asics won the 14 Open National Championship, TAV's 2nd of the tournament and doubled the number of National Championships in Texas history. Congratulations to all the outstanding teams that should keep TAV number one in Texas for the 6th straight year!!
